

## ACCESSING INFORMATION

1. Demonstrate the ability to use the Internet for a variety of information finding purposes.
2. Demonstrate familiarity with transportation information systems, such as bus schedules, flight information, and map reading, etc.
3. Demonstrate the ability to utilize basic library information systems.
4. Demonstrate the ability to utilize sources of legal, social, & governmental assistance and information (social services, crisis networks, and consumer information, etc.).
5. Demonstrate the ability to use current communication systems.
6. Demonstrate independent living skills, such as knowledge of checking and savings accounts, finding housing, license and insurance issues, credit, & taxes.
7. Demonstrate an understanding of project-based learning.
8. Demonstrate the ability to set up a community learning experience.
9. Demonstrate the ability to conceptualize learning opportunities that would meet all or part of each validation area.
10. Demonstrate the ability to evaluate the credibility of sources.
11. Demonstrate the ability to cite research sources.
